

## PhD Proposal Appraisal Committee Member Approval Form

All PhD candidates are examined on the progress of their PhD program at a Proposal Appraisal ideally held in the second year of studies. The examination consists of a 20 minute presentation given by the student on the proposed thesis work followed by a question period of approximately one and a half to two hours. The emphasis of the exam is on the theory and proposed approach, rather than on progress to date.
