Administrative user fees must relate to the cost of the services provided, and may not exceed the \$, or a reasonable estimate of the \$.

The only administrative user fees and fines that may be charged are those shown on the University's Schedule of Fees and Fines.

The fees and fines shown on the Schedule of Fees and Fines are established annually by the administrative authority at the Vice-Provost and Assistant Vice-President (Planning & Budget) provided that the administrative fees relate to the cost of the services provided.

All charges shall be reported annually to the Business Board for information. The introduction or removal of a fee from the Schedule of Fees must be submitted to the Business Board for review and approval.

All fees in this category are exempt from the Ministry of Education and Training's protocol requirements.

7.2% General program support

In addition to tuition fees, no fees may be levied for general program support, except as provided for in Category 7.2%, student levies for specific, limited projects.

7.2% Student Service Fees

Student fees are established through a formal agreement under which students at all Ontario universities pay a comparable fee for a comparable service. Student fees are exempt from the Ministry of Education and Training's Compulsory Ancillary Fee Policy protocol requirements.

7.21 Universal Health Insurance Plan (UHIP)

This is a new category introduced by the Ministry of Education and Training. The UHIP fee is actually a Council of Ontario University fee which is reported here for information.
